### **OVERVIEW**

45 Park Lane feels like a sleek private residence in the heart of London, where 45 Art Deco-inspired rooms and suites overlook beautiful Hyde Park. For dining, CUT at 45 Park Lane is Wolfgang Puck's first European restaurant, where works by Damien Hirst line the walls. Upstairs BAR 45 awaits with a vibrant mix of handcrafted cocktails, 'Rough CUTs' and the famous vintage Negronis, where guests sit amongst an ever-evolving collection of contemporary art.

### **HISTORY**

45 Park Lane has lived various lives, including one particularly glamorous adventure as The Playboy Club. Nicknamed 'the hutch on the park', this was a fashionable 1960s hangout for London's rich and famous.

Originally designed as an office building by famed Bauhaus architect Walter Gropius, it remains a landmark of London, and today, a treasured gem of Dorchester Collection.

# **DÉCOR**

The master behind the interior design of 45 Park Lane is Thierry Despont; architect, curator, artist and designer. Taking inspiration from his own idiosyncratic world of art, Despont has created a deeply personal living environment that provides the canvas for a collection of art by current British artists. Despont believes that every aspect is a reflection of the personality of those that inhabit it. This philosophy extends to his vision for 45 Park Lane, which he designed as if it were a private residence.

Both the London location and the intimate size of the hotel defines the overall character, while interiors are decorated in a contemporary style with Art Deco influences such as rich dark natural materials, contrasting with light colours and sensual textures. The striking façade is covered in distinctive horizontal 'fins' to complement the building's naturally curvaceous figure.

# **ART**

45 Park Lane is a potent, living canvas for an ever-evolving collection of work by contemporary British artists. Alongside permanent displays by the likes of Damien Hirst and Sir Peter Blake, regular exhibitions offer guests a chance to discover new local artists through vibrant collages, photography, sculptures and print.

## **ROOMS AND SUITES**

Art Deco in style, yet contemporary in attitude, the hotel's 46 rooms and suites gleam with modern luxury. Inside, clean lines and bold design add shape to buttery soft fabrics, while sensual curves reflect in sparkling mirrored detail. Each room and suite overlooks Hyde Park opposite, while the glorious Penthouse Suite features a wraparound terrace with panoramic views across the London skyline.

#### **CUT at 45 Park Lane**

CUT at 45 Park Lane is Wolfgang Puck's debut restaurant in Europe, where guests enjoy a vibrant blend of a succulent menu, sleek design and fascinating art. This is a cool twist on the modern American steak restaurant, with space for 70 diners.

#### **BAR 45**

Upstairs, BAR 45 is a sophisticated space exuding glamour and comfort, where the bartenders mix and shake handcrafted cocktails and signature Negronis. This is a lively spot for people-watching and cocktail-sipping, where a bar menu of 'Rough CUTs' goes down well with a glass of rare liquor or something from the extensive wine list.

Behind a discreet doorway, poised elegantly above Park Lane and yet a million miles from the world below, Sushi Kanesaka's exclusive Michelin-starred dining event transports guests to another realm, where an adventure through refinement awaits to fascinate the senses.
